Children will continue to consolidate their understanding of number. They will be looking closely at place value and strategies for adding and subtracting numbers. We will also focus on measurement (mass, capacity and temperature.)

Science:

Our topic this term is materials. Children will develop their understanding of materials and their properties. They will be given the opportunity to strengthen their scientific enquiry skills. We will be visiting the Herstmonceux Science Observatory to explore some important inventions.

Geography:

Identify the major oceans and continents using maps, atlases and the correct directional vocabulary.

Music:

During Music lessons, we will continue to use a variety of musical instruments and rehearse simple melodies.

REAL Dance and PE:

This term we are focusing on the 'COGNITIVE' cog which involves making good decisions, understanding simple tactics of attacking/defending and analysing performance.
