	Learning Objective	Activity
Mon	Make predictions	<p>Listen to the input on Microsoft Teams at 9:30am or read through the literacy slides for Monday (found on the website).</p> <p>Today we are starting a new book. In this lesson, we will look at an illustration and the first paragraph of the book. You will write a prediction on what the story will be about!</p>
Tues	Describe a character	<p>Listen to the input on Microsoft Teams at 9:30am or read through the literacy slides for Tuesday (found on the website).</p> <p>Today we are going to explore the main character of the story, Zoe. Using the template, write down all you know about Zoe’s appearance and personality.</p>
Weds	Identify the features of a dystopian story	<p>Listen to the input on Microsoft Teams at 9:30am or read through the literacy slides for Wednesday (found on the website).</p> <p>Today we will discuss what dystopian fiction is and think about books and films we know which are similar to Floodland. You will make a mind map that considers the plots, characters, settings and description of this type of writing.</p>

We will create a word bank to help describe the setting as Zoe approaches it on her boat.</p>
