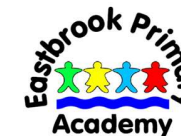

Mon	Understand newspaper features	<p>Input: Watch Monday's literacy video by Mrs Sutcliff and Mr Button. What is a newspaper? Why do we have them? Watch the first video- https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/z9jgn9q To make a newspaper you need certain features. We will be focusing on headlines (eye catching, bold, alliterations, humour, serious, short/snappy), Photos and captions (snapshot and label for photo) Quotes (who is talking?), Emotive writing and language (terrified, starving, frantic), and opening paragraph (who?
