Dear Parents and Carers

We would like to give you an update on the school situation this week. We are receiving guidance from REAch2 and the Department for Education on a daily basis. The school will remain open, at present, however if your child has a new cough and/or raised temperature they will need to remain at home, in isolation, for seven days as per the guidance from Public Health England.

To minimise risk of spreading the virus, whilst all internal assemblies with the children are still happening there will be no class curriculum assemblies with parents this half term.

All reading mornings for EYFS, Y1 and Y2 are also cancelled for this half term.

All sporting events and competitions with other schools have been either cancelled or postponed until further notice.

School trips will be risk assessed on an individual basis and we will take into account whether they are based inside or outside and the number of people at the venue. Unfortunately other events are being cancelled by the organisers and we will keep you informed if your child is involved, as soon as we have the information.

The Y3 trip to the Planetarium in Chichester on Thursday is currently planned to go ahead as we will be the only school in attendance and they have taken all possible precautions according to the current Coronavirus advice.

We will keep you updated as and when we have further information, including whether we need to cancel our Easter raffle. Thank you for your support at this uncertain time.
