
# **Synonyms and Antonyms**


gynonyms and antonyms are completely different things — make sure you don't mix them up.

## Synonyms Mean the Same Thing



hefty

These synonyms could replace the word 'heavu' and the sentence would have the same meaning.



weightu

#### Antonyms are Opposites

An <u>antonym</u> is a word that means the <u>opposite</u> of another word.



The car stopped suddenly.

These antonyms have the opposite meaning to suddenly.

slowly

gradually

gently


