English tasks:

- Practise these core objectives

 - ★ Add and subtract any numbers up to 20 in your head.
 - ★ Know the multiplication and division facts for 2, 5 and 10 times table.
 - ★ Tell and write the time to the nearest 5 minutes.

Science tasks:

- ★ Make a list of materials found around your home. Can you sort them into groups?
- ★ Find out about an Arctic animal and why it is well adapted to its environment.
- ★ Observe and describe what happens to ice after it is taken out of the freezer.

History tasks:


- ★ Write some quiz questions about the Great Fire of London.
