Learning focus this week: Time			
Mon	Learning objective:	Learning activities:	
	Convert years to months and weeks to days	<i>Watch Monday's Maths Video</i> Discuss how many days in a week, how many weeks in a month (explain that it is roughly 4 but not always exactly), how many months in a year. <b>Task: Complete the worksheet, filling in missing numbers. Answer the challenge reasoning questions.</b>	
Tues	Learning objective:	Learning activities:	
	Convert hours to minutes and minutes to seconds	<i>Watch Tuesday's Maths Video</i> Discuss with children that there are 60 seconds in 1 minute and 60 minutes in 1 hour. <b>Task: Complete the 10 questions converting to seconds and minutes. Challenge 1 – two word problems. Challenge 2 – reasoning question.</b>	
Weds	Learning objective	Learning activities:	
	Tell the time on an analogue clock	<i>Watch Wednesday's Maths Video</i> Look at an analogue clock, explain that each interval is 5 minutes. Everything before 30 is past and everything after 30 is to. Use the picture of an analogue clock to help. <b>Task: Play the Analogue Clock Board Game. Either with a sibling or on their own, every time they land on a clock face they need to say the time out loud and write it down.</b>

	Convert between analogue and digital time	<i>Watch Thursday's Maths Video</i> Play this game to practice converting between analogue and digital time: <a href="https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/116/telling-the-time">https://mathsframe.co.uk/en/resources/resource/116/telling-the-time</a> <b>Task: Complete the worksheet. Task 1 – fill in the missing digital and analogue times. Task 2 – match the analogue time to the correct digital time.</b>

	Recall times tables and Sumdog challenge	<i>Watch Friday's Maths Video</i> Children will need to work on their individual times table. We have attached all the times tables tests on the website. They can have time to revise and practice their times tables before completing the test.
