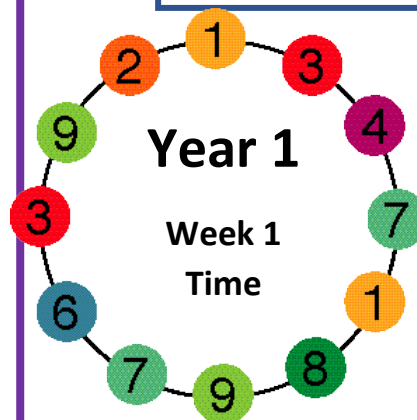

Is Holly correct? Explain your reasoning.

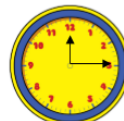


The time is 6 past 1
