Welcome to our Year 3 Autumn Term Homework Activity sheet. We have some exciting tasks and challenges which can be completed throughout this term. You will receive some additional homework for Maths every 2 weeks. Please hand in your homework books on a **Wednesday** so that we can check and mark the progress throughout the term.

English: Choose at least 5 tasks

- **Read daily!** Write a response to your reading:
 - Write a 'blurb' for the back cover
 - Describe a favourite character
 - Recount part of the story in your own way
 - Write a letter to a character
 - Write a book review
 - Read to someone and ask them to write a comment
- **Practise spellings** from year 3/4 word list
- Write a list of verbs in their PRESENT and PAST forms:
e.g run -> ran eat->ate
- Write an acrostic poem for the words ANCIENT EGYPT.
- Make a list of **homophones** e.g meat and meet. Write a sentence that includes each word.
- Write a glossary of Ancient Egypt topic words e.g sarcophagus

Art/ Design and Technology:

- Create your own hieroglyphic symbols for letters of the alphabet. Then write a message using your new symbols!

Science: Choose at least 3 tasks.

Light and Shadow

- Investigate how ancient civilisations used to tell the time then create an ancient sundial.
- Design a beautiful stained-glass window and look at how the light changes.

Animals including humans

- Design your own balanced meal.
- Create a poster that explains how part of the body works e.g skeleton, muscles and heart.
- Find examples of animals that are carnivore, herbivore and omnivore. Write down what they eat.

History: Choose at least 1 task.

- Ancient Egypt: Find out who was known as the 'Boy King' and present your findings as a fact file.
- Find out what items were buried with a mummy for the journey to the afterlife.

Geography: Choose at least 1 task.

- Where are the major deserts of the world? Show them on a simple outline map.
- Find out about the River Nile. How long is it? Where does it start and finish? Why is it important?
