Each week your child will be asked to practise a list of words There is an activity for your child to complete. - Using chalks on the pavement.

A teaching assistant will ask your child to read and spell these words and then, if they can read and spell the majority of the words correctly, they will be able to move anto the next word list.

Once your child has completed the whole booklet there will be a selection of board games or fun activities for your child to choose from. We ask that they continue to practise these words on a regular basis, choosing a variety of words from the word lists in this booklet
