### English tasks:

- ★ Read every day!

### Maths tasks:

- Practise these core objectives
- ★ Make totals in different ways:  
e.g.  $23 = 20 + 3$  or  $10 + 13$

  - ★ Know the multiplication and division facts for 2, 5 and 10 times table
  - ★ Tell and write the time including quarter past and quarter to

### Science tasks:

- ★ Find 5 'inventions' around your home and describe why they are useful
- ★ Why aren't hammers made from sponge? Why aren't umbrellas made of paper? Explain why!
- ★ Test which material soaks up water the best: toilet roll, kitchen paper, sponge or newspaper. Record and explain your findings!

### History tasks:


- ★ Create a poster about a famous inventor e.g Tim Berners-Lee, Maria Beasley
