

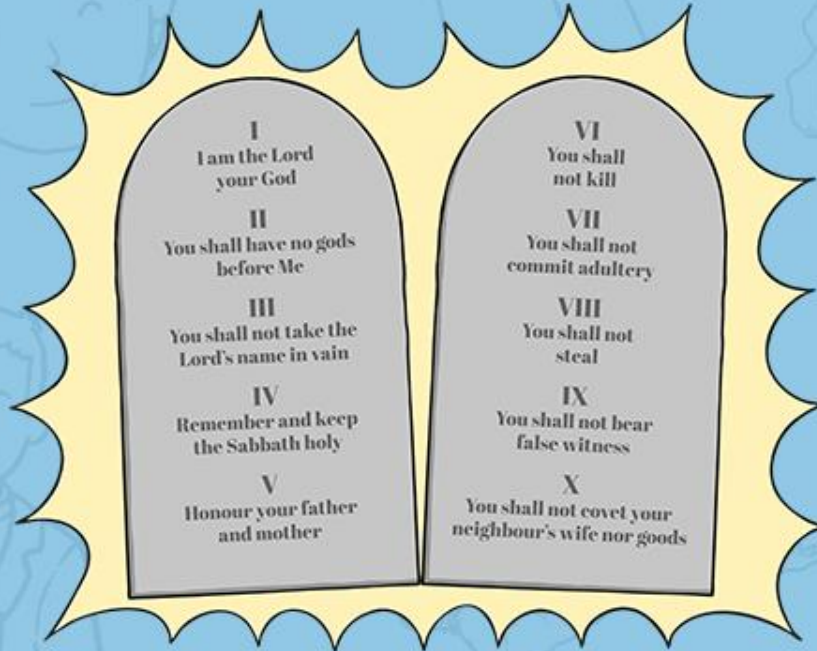

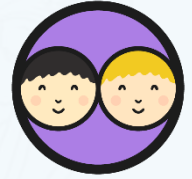

# What Are the Ten Commandments?

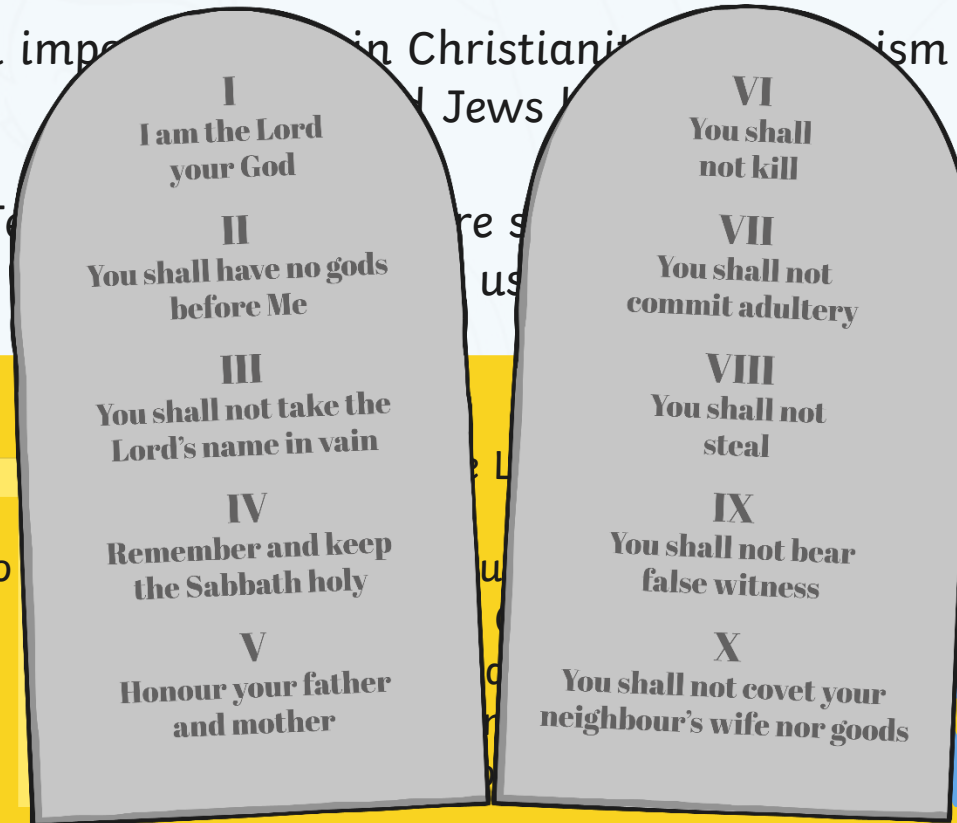
The Ten Commandments are a set of rules.

The Ten Commandments can be found in the Old Testament of the Bible and the Torah (Jewish scriptures).

Scripture states that God gave them on two stone tablets to Moses on Mount Sinai.

Put God first.

**You shall not make idols, bow down to them or worship them.**



Do not let anything be more important than God.

name in vain.**



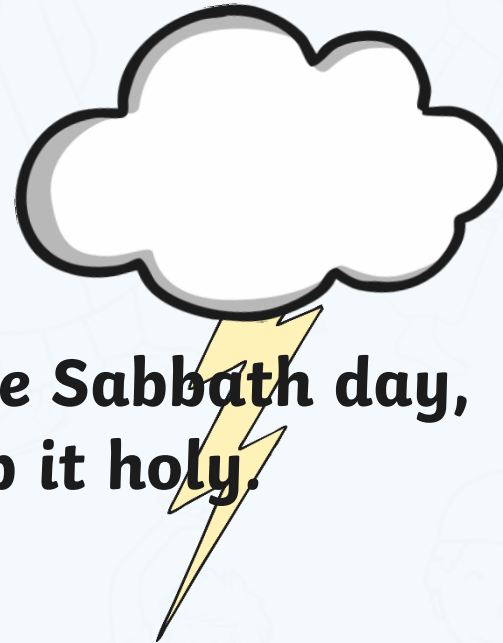
Do not misuse God's name.
