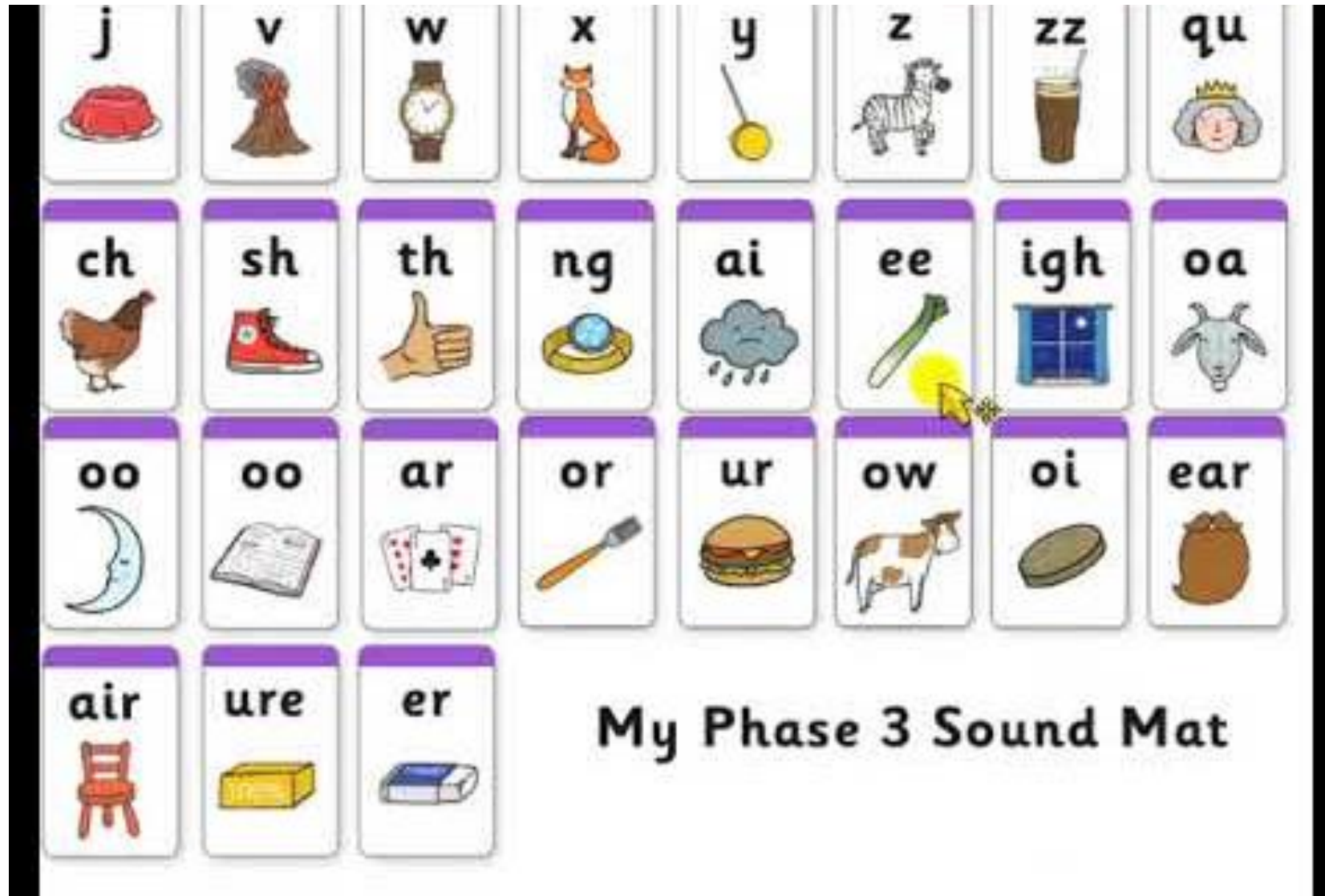

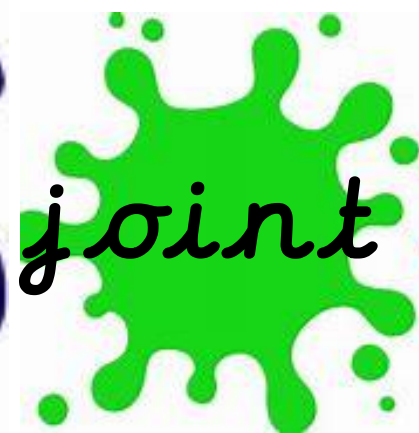
oy oi oy oi

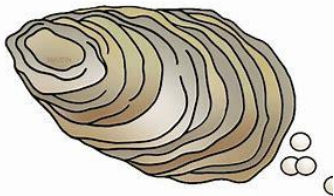


