TBAT: Solve subtraction problems

Use a number square to work out these word problems.

A shop has 45 bouncy balls. They sell 20 in a day. How many balls are left at the end of the day?

> Sally has 50p. She spends 10p on sweets. How much money did she have left?

Charlie had 58 marbles. His brother borrows 30 of them. How many marbles does Charlie have left?

> Ben had 78 strawberries. His friends ate 40. How many strawberries are left?

There are 56 children in Year 2. 30 pupils are on a school trip. How many pupils are left at school?

Belle took 77 seconds to run to the nearest tree. After practising she was able to get to the tree 10 seconds earlier. How long did it take her to run to the tree this time?

CHALLENGE subtraction problems

Draw a number line to work out the answers to these word problems.

Sally has 90 marbles. She loses 28 of them. How many marbles does Sally now have?

> Harvey has a party. There are 67 slices of pizza at the start. By the end of the party 46 slices were eaten. How many slices of pizza were left over?

There are 60 seats on a train carriage. 37 seats are taken. How many seats have no one sitting in them?

> 79 people are at the beach on the sand. 28 of them decide to go swimming in the sea. How many people are still on the sand?

A shop has 55 teddy bears at the beginning of the week. During the week 33 got sold. How many teddy bears does the shop still have by the end of the week?
