The Hanukkah Menorah

The Hanukkah menorah is a nine-branched candle holder.

One candle is lit each night during Hanukkah. The candles are placed from right to left, but lit from left to right.




The branch in the middle is called the shamash. This is the place for the candle that is used to light all the other candles.



The Hanukkah menorah is also known as chanukiah or hanukiah.

Why Is Light Important at Hanukkah?

In the story of Hanukkah, King Antiochus destroyed a beautiful Jewish temple. The Maccabee brothers fought against the King and won.

The light was very helpful to the Maccabee brothers. It meant that they were able to complete a very important job: rebuilding the beautiful Jewish temple.




Making a Hanukkah Menorah
