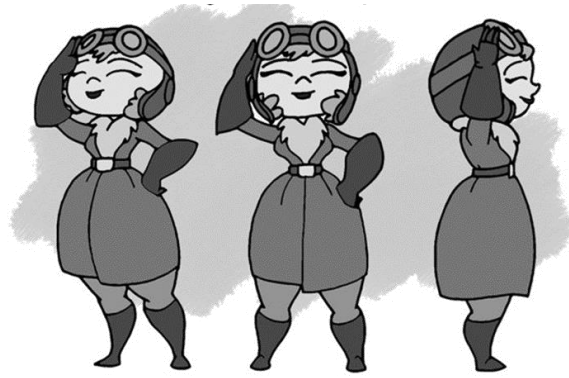

The incredible pilot saw her first plane at a fair when she was 10 years old.

Her first plane was a bright yellow Kinner Airster that she nicknamed, "The Canary".

Her nickname was 'Lady Lindy', after she flew across the Atlantic Ocean in 1928.

The courageous explorer became the first person to fly solo across the Pacific in 1932. It was a 2,408-mile journey.

She always enjoyed drinking a cup of hot chocolate while flying.

The brave jet setter didn't like to wear goggles while flying.

She developed flying clothes for a fashion range that were advertised in Vogue.

Despite her many achievements, the daring pioneer didn't stop chasing her dreams. In June 1937, she intended to travel the world but she disappeared somewhere over the Pacific Ocean.
