

Main Task:

Change the fairy-tale sentences below from past tense to present perfect tense. Imagine you are reporting this on the news or in a newspaper. Present perfect tense means it has already happened, but it has an effect on now.

TOP TIP: use has or have in your sentences.

Example: Little Red baked some cakes for her Grandma (past tense)

Little Red has baked some cakes for her Grandma (present perfect tense)

- 2. Jack, a young boy on a local farm, dissappeared up a giant beanstalk.
- 3. Hansel and Gretel were found wandering around the dark forest.
- 4. A vicious walf, who lives in the forest, ate Little Red's Grandma.
