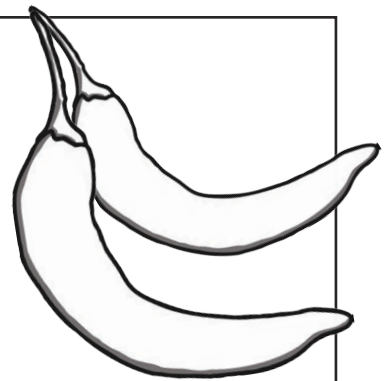
## Challenge
