Dear Parents and Carers

A visit to Preston Manor has been arranged for your child's class to take place on Monday 1st October. During the visit the children will take part in Victorian role play. They will find out how the Victorians lived, what jobs the servants did in the house and they will even apply for a position at the manor house! We would like the children to come to school dressed in their Victorian clothes for the whole day.

We have arranged for the children to travel by coach. The visit will take place during normal school hours, however 4CP will be a little late back to school as their session finishes at 3.00pm. We anticipate they will return to school by 3.30pm at the latest.

All of the children will need to bring a packed lunch and two drinks (one carton of drink or flask for their lunch and a bottle of water to take to Preston Manor). If your child is in receipt of free school meals, a lunch will be provided on the day but it would be advisable to provide your child with a bottle of water for the trip and a few extra items of food.

Please can you pay a voluntary contribution of £15.50 per child which includes transport, entrance, workshops and insurance for the day. We would be grateful if you would complete the permission form below, and return this to the office by Friday 28th September. If you are unable to contribute in full please see the school office in confidence. You may, if you wish, pay for this trip in two instalments by paying £8.50 now and the balance of £7.00 by Friday 28th September. We would prefer this trip to be paid via Parent Pay. **If we do not receive enough contributions we may have to cancel the trip.**
