This week, practise your 7 times table! Here are some activities to help you:

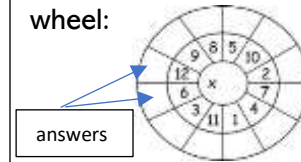
**Speed tables! How quickly can you write or say the answers to a times table you are learning?**

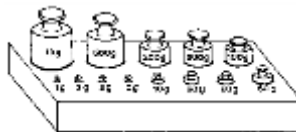


## Pair me up!

## Show me the money!
