First, read the Anne Frank text you have been provided and complete the comprehension activities that come with it. Additionally, you can choose from some of the activities below.

Underline any words in the text you do not understand. Find out their meanings and write them down.

Make a list of any plural nouns you spot in the text e.g. jobs, boxes, butterflies.

Underline any prefixes (e.g. unhappy) and suffixes (e.g. strongest)

Make a colour key and highlight 5 nouns, 5 verbs and 5 adjectives in different colours.

Find some adjectives in the text and write a synonym for each e.g. big → large, happy → pleased

Find any words that contain apostrophes for contracted words. Write them like below:

isn't → is not

he'll → he will

What tense is the text mainly written in, past or present?
Copy two examples.

Then rewrite the sentences you have chosen by changing any verbs to a different tense

Write an alternative title or sub-headings for the text.

Write 5 questions of your own, based on the text. Ask an adult to answer them! Are they right?
