

Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar (SPAG)

Paper 1

- 40 50 short answer questions.
- Covers grammar, punctuation and vocabulary.
- 45 minutes

Paper 2

- 20 spellings
- 15 minutes



Reading

One reading comprehension paper

- Questions based on 3 or 4 texts of increasing difficulty.
- A total of 35-40 questions of increasing difficulty.
- A total of 50 marks.
- One hour in total, including reading time.



Mathematics



Paper 1 - Arithmetic

- 40 marks across approximately 36 questions.
- 30 minutes


Paper 2 - Reasoning

- 35 marks across approximately 23 questions.
- 40 minutes

Paper 3 - Reasoning

- 35 marks across approximately 23 questions.
- 40 minutes
