- One hour in total, including reading time.

- 40 marks across approximately 36 questions.
- 30 minutes

Paper 2 - Reasoning

- 35 marks across approximately 23 questions.
- 40 minutes

Paper 3 - Reasoning

- 35 marks across approximately 23 questions.
- 40 minutes
