Eva: The capacity of the pot is 2 l and 300 ml.

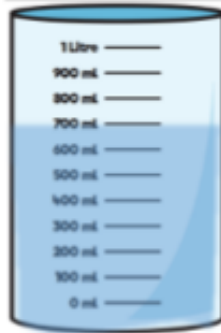


Who do you agree with?

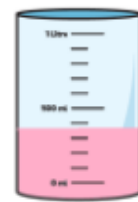
