



Eggsellent Easter Activities

Over the Easter Holidays, try to complete as many of these eggciting Easter activities as you can!



Read some stories linked to Easter, rabbits, chickens etc

Design and decorate your own Easter egg. Now write sentences to describe it!

Write an acrostic poem about Easter or Spring

Play a board game or make your own!

Make chocolate nest cakes

Learn some Easter jokes

Bunny, Bunny, Rabbit (a version of duck, duck, goose!)

Sit in a circle with your family and select one someone to be "it". The "it" child walks around the outside of the circle patting each person on the head and saying "bunny" until they want to say "RABBIT".

Both the "it" child and the RABBIT must hop around the circle trying to reach the vacant spot. Whoever doesn't make it to the spot in time is then "it".

Egg and Spoon race! Who will win?

Make some 'nature perfume' by mixing daisies, dandelions and green leaves in water.

Collage an outline of an Easter Egg with colourful pieces of paper torn from a magazine or newspaper.

Make an Easter Card to send in the post to a family member.

Turn some old socks into hand puppets and put on a show from behind the sofa!

Hold an indoor scavenger hunt! First to find...something white! Something fluffy!...Something square!...A coin!

Pretend to be a rabbit!
