Use the number square for a range of different tasks!

1. Practise reading and writing the numbers up to 100
2. Practise counting – count in steps of 2, 5 and 10
3. Find one more, one less, ten more or ten less than a number
4. Use the number square to help with simple addition (e.g. $24 + 12$) or subtraction (e.g. $40 - 8$)
5. Cover up different numbers – can the children tell you which ones are covered? Can they write them down?
6. Can they tell you the number of tens and ones in a number? (e.g. 56 has 5 tens (50) and 6 ones)
7. Use the number square to play a game of snakes and ladders!
