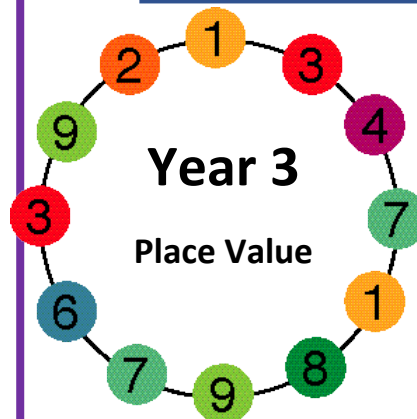
A number is rounded to 170

### What's my number?

1. I am a three-digit number. My tens digit is five more than my ones digit. My hundreds digit is eight less than my tens digit. What number am I?
2. My number has three digits. The ones digit is 72 less than 81. The hundreds digit is an odd number which is bigger than 1 but smaller than 4. The tens digit is the same as  $5 + 4$ . What's my number?
